- One year there lasts only 88 Earth days.

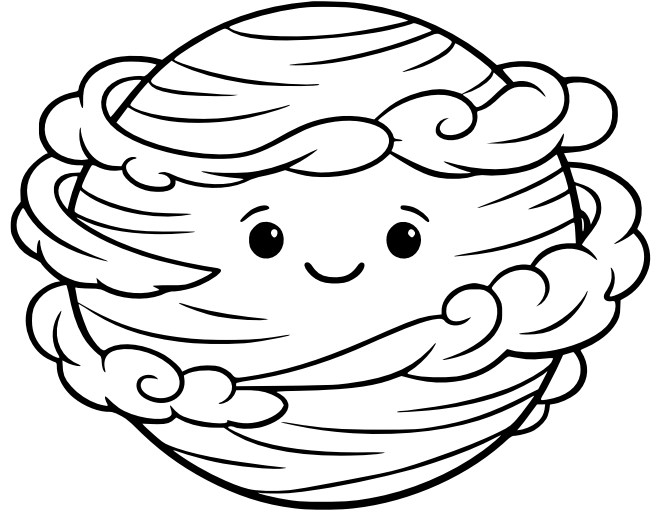
- It has no moons at all.

- The hottest planet in the solar system.

- The second planet from the Sun.

- Almost the same size as Earth.

- It spins in the opposite direction to Earth.

- Oceans cover most of its surface.

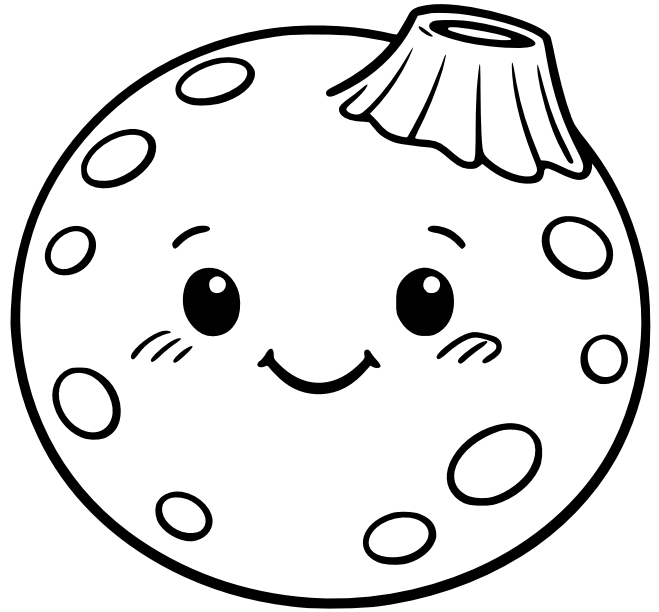
- It has one moon, the Moon.

- It has two small moons, Phobos and Deimos.

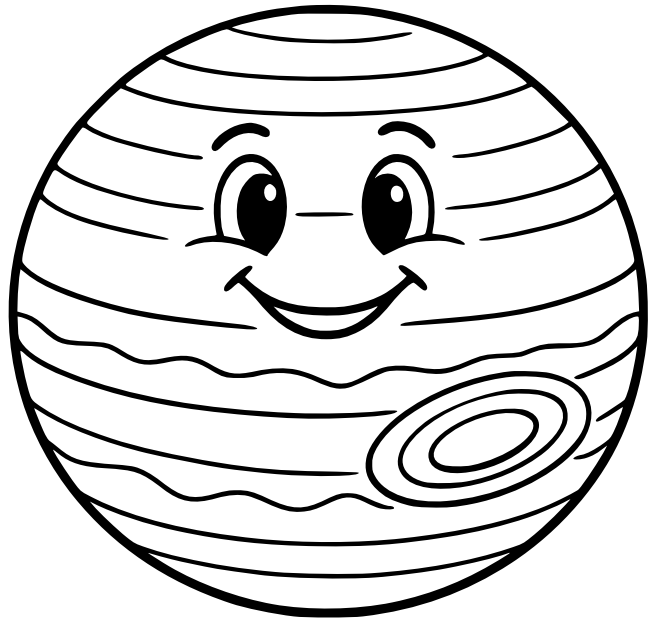
- Home of Olympus Mons, the tallest volcano known.

- Its Great Red Spot is a giant storm.

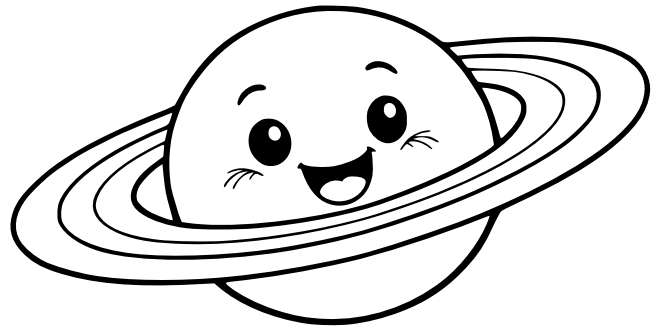
- More than 90 moons orbit around it.

- The second biggest planet.

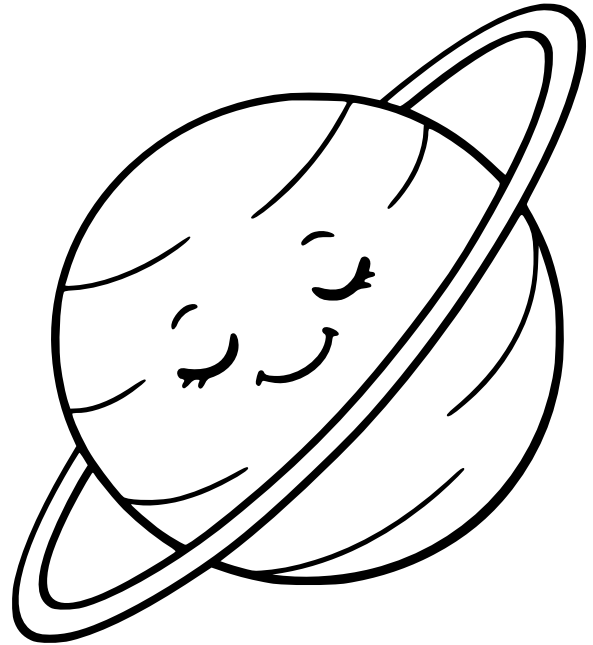
- More than 100 moons orbit around it.

- An ice giant with thin, faint rings.

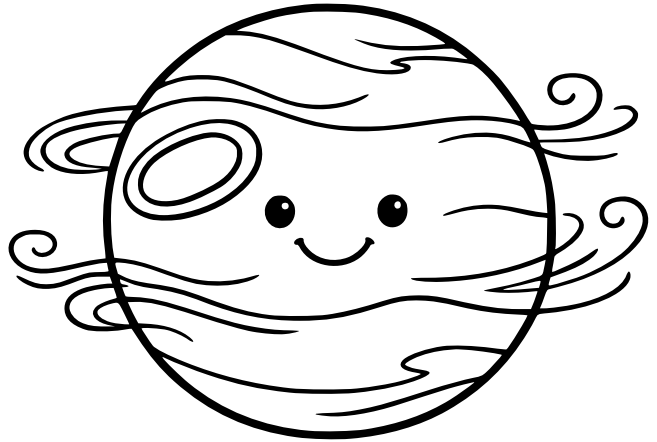
- Its cloud tops are icy cold.
